Though it says Buddhist Ceylon, all the essays are not on Buddhism alone; there are 6 essays offered: a Buddhist Sabbath in Ceylon; Olcott day at Galle; the Story of the Weavers Daughter; an Ordination for the Buddhist Monk; at the foot of a tree; and the last essay is on the Metteyya (Maitriya) Bodhisattava. There are 8 b/w photos in this book, which was first published in 1914.
