Section 2464 of title 10 provides for a Department of Defense ()-maintained core logistics capability that is to be DOD government-owned and-operated and that is sufficient to ensure the technical competence and resources necessary for an effective and timely response to a mobilization or other national emergency. Section 2466 prohibits the use of more than 50 percent of the funds made available in a fiscal year for depot-level maintenance and repair to contract for the performance of the work by nonfederal personnel.
